

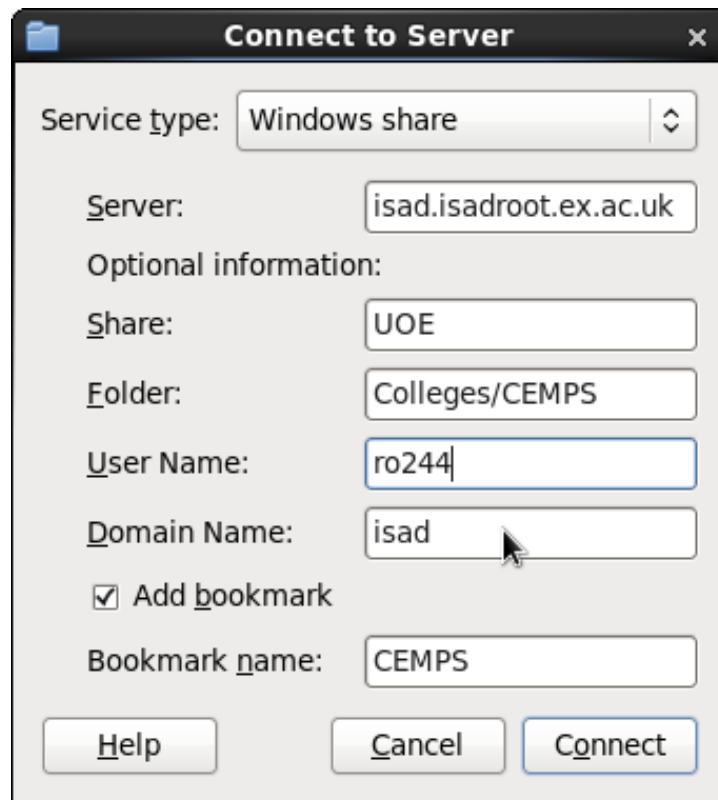
## Connecting to the College Shared Network Drive

### Windows

- Open “Computer”.
- Click on “Map network drive” in the toolbar.
- Select N: in the drive drop-down box.
- Type [\\isad.isadroot.ex.ac.uk\uoecolleges\CEMPS](http://isad.isadroot.ex.ac.uk/uoecolleges/CEMPS) in the folder box.
- Ensure “Reconnect at logon” is checked.
- If you logon to your computer not using your standard Exeter username then tick the “Connect using different credentials” box.
- Click finish.
- If you are asked to authenticate, enter your username in the form isad\username with your standard password.

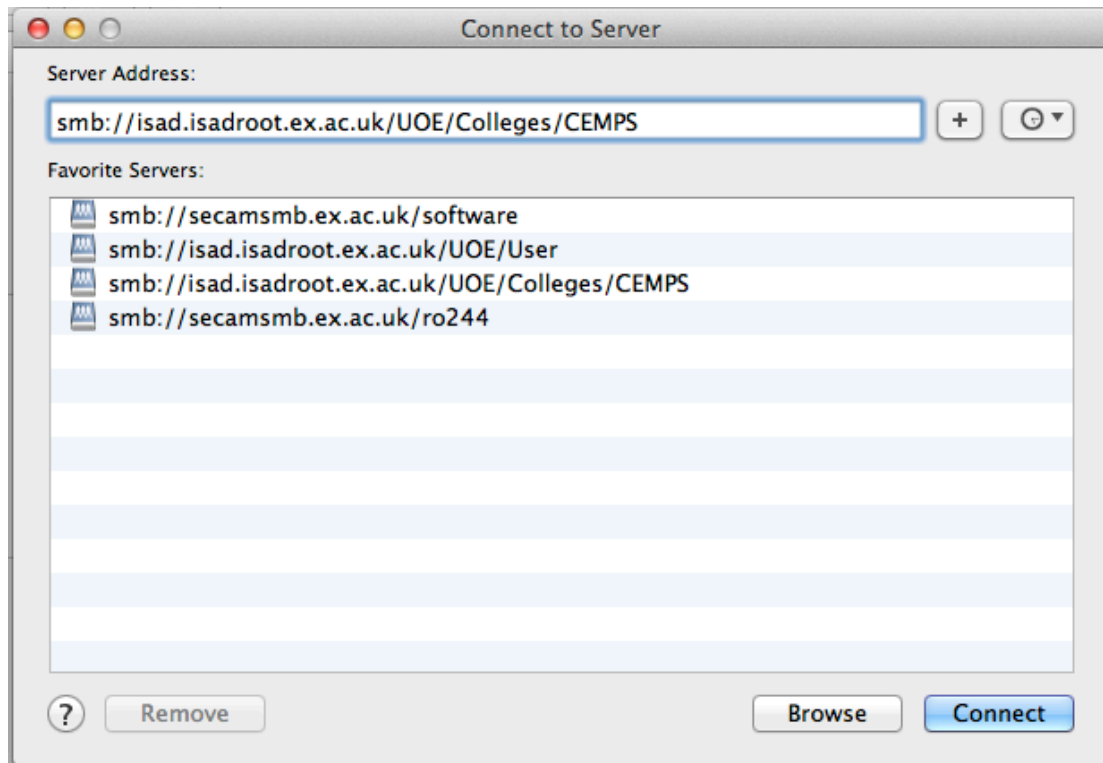
### Linux (Scientific Linux 6)

- Click Places -> Connect to server...
- Complete the fields as per the image below (with your own username).
- This will then appear as a “bookmark” under the Places menu.



## Mac

- Open “Finder”.
- Click Go -> Connect to server... (or the keyboard shortcut Command-K).
- Type smb://isad.isadroot.ex.ac.uk/UOE/Colleges/CEMPS in the Server Address box.
- Click the + button to add it to “Favorite Servers”.
- Click Connect.



- Enter your username and password.
- Tick the “Remember this password...” if you don’t want to have to enter the details every time you connect.
